After hearing time has been confirmed with the Judicial Assistant, please provide within **seven (7)** days, a courtesy copy of the **Notice of Hearing and Motion(s)** to be heard via U. S. Mail to the county listed below:

Telephonic Appearance for Attorneys:

The **attorney(s)** requesting to appear telephonically, shall contact opposing attorney, indicate whether all are in agreement in motion. Submit Agreed Motion and Order to Appear within **10** days before the hearing to allow for processing of the order. The attorney(s) shall initiate the call to the Judge's office with all parties on the same line before calling the Judge's office at the above numbers for **each** county.

Telephonic Appearance for Pro Se Litigant(s):

Pro Se Litigant(s) requesting to appear telephonically, must submit a motion and proposed order to the Judge's office ten days before the hearing and are to appear with a **Notary** and proper **identification**.
