TALLAHASSEE, FL – Residents in need of legal assistance are invited to attend a **FREE Legal Clinic** hosted by the **Second Judicial Circuit Pro Bono Committee** on **Saturday, April 18, 2026**, from **9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.** at **R. Frank Nims Middle School**.

This community-focused clinic is designed to support individuals across the Big Bend region by providing access to volunteer attorneys who can offer free legal advice, guidance, and assistance on a variety of civil legal issues.

Attendees will be helped on a first-come, first-served basis, depending on attorney availability. Individuals are encouraged to bring any relevant documents or paperwork related to their legal questions.
